Dear North Side Families,

REMINDER ELEMENTARY STUDENTS RETURN TO CAMPUS, NOV. 2, 2020

We heard you! After careful consideration and reviewing the data from the "returning to school survey", we are returning to school in person! Our decisions were based on your input. We value your concerns:

There are 2 options: *Option 1) all day in-person* (Classes will run four days a week, (M,T,TH,F), and Wednesday's (½ day) from 8:30 to 12:00 pm will be virtual for ALL students). In person class sizes will be as small as social distancing allows. *Option 2) All Virtual, all day at home.*

Students must remain in their chosen option through Christmas break. Our return date will be November 2, 2020. Once you have made your choice of in person or virtual you **MAY NOT change**. We need to reduce the amount of contact students are having with each other as much as possible.

In Person Class- School hours are from 8:30am to 2:30pm.

- Bus transportation will be provided
- Parents, taxis, daycare vans etc. drop-off time will be 8:15am (**NO EARLIER**)
- Breakfast begins in class at 8:15am and ends at 8:40am
- Instruction begins promptly at 8:45am
- **A mask must be worn the entire school day by staff and STUDENTS.**

Virtual Class - school hours are from 8:30am - 2:30pm (small groups may go on to 3:30pm)

If students choose the virtual learning option, please note:

- Students will remain with their previously assigned teacher
- Students will live stream through zoom to attend classes daily with their teacher
- Guardians will need to keep an extra close eye on their students and provide technology support as teachers are less available due to teaching both in person and virtual
- Technology Support - **DO NOT** call your teacher for technical support, they are busy teaching. Please call **314-385-9502** and ask for Mike (Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays) and Sheila (Tuesdays and Thursday)

COVID- 19 Procedures:

- Temperature checks will be performed at both the bus stops before loading the bus and at Parent Drop Offs upon arrival
- Children with a temperature of 100.4 degrees must stay home, the child will not be allowed to enter the bus or the school.
- Parents will be responsible for providing masks before the students depart to school, from home daily
- VISITORS are not allowed into the buildings. Contact the office by phone at 314-385-9502.
